Notice of Privacy Practices (NPP)

This Notice of Privacy Practices describes how medical information about you may be used and disclosed and how you can get access to this information. Please review it carefully.

Our Responsibilities

Community Behavioral Health Alliance (CBHA) is required by law to maintain the privacy of your health information, provide you with this Notice of Privacy Practices, and abide by the terms of this notice.

How We May Use and Disclose Health Information

We may use and share your health information for treatment, payment, and health care operations without your written authorization. Examples include sharing information with other providers involved in your care, billing Medi-Cal, and conducting quality assessments.

Other Uses and Disclosures

We may also use and share your information as permitted or required by law, such as for public health activities, reporting abuse or neglect, responding to legal requests, and to avert a serious threat to health or safety.

Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request a copy of your medical record.
- Request corrections to your record.
- Request restrictions on certain uses and disclosures.
- Request confidential communications.
- Receive an accounting of disclosures.
- Obtain a paper copy of this notice upon request.

Changes to This Notice

We reserve the right to change this notice and make the new notice apply to information we already have as well as new information we receive in the future. A current copy will always be available upon request and on our website.
